



Congratulations to our Round 12 Recipients



This year, despite challenging times for schools, businesses and community organisations, we received 29 iPromise Grant applications adding up to over \$230,000!

Our judging panel were impressed with the innovative ideas to address this year's theme 'Water Conservation' and applauded all of our applicants for their efforts to conserve resources and reduce their environmental impact.

We thank our judging panel from Rana Environmental, Power Waste Management and the NSW Office of Planning, Industry & Environment for their expertise and involvement in judging the applications and congratulate the following recipients:

Minerva SSP - \$1,050

Minerva SSP are installing a rain water tank to assist in watering their existing Kitchen Garden.

Primbee Public School- \$700

Primbee have fundraised to purchase an irrigation pump for their existing vegetable garden and will use their iPromise Grant to fit the pump to their water tank and install the irrigation piping and drip system.

Jannali Public School - \$4,000

Jannali PS are installing an outdoor watering system as well as a water bottle refill station.

Caringbah Public School - \$5,170

Caringbah PS are implementing a water wise system including rainwater tanks and pumps.

Dulwich Hill Public School - \$1,500

Dulwich Hill will be converting their edible garden beds to wicking beds which they anticipate will result in water savings of up to 80%.

Como Public School - \$2,025

The Como PS Garden Club will use their grant to improve water efficiency through a water wise irrigation system and pea straw mulch for their edible garden.

Phoenix Community Project - \$1,338

The Phoenix Community Project plans to conserve water with a new rain water tank and irrigation system.

Tarrawanna Public School - \$3,275

Tarrawanna PS are fitting pumps to their water tanks to improve the water efficiency of their permaculture, bush tucker, fruit, vegetable and herb gardens.

East Hills Boys High School - \$1,291

East Hills Boys High School plan to install Vegepod wicking self-watering garden beds to provide their school with a sustainable, water conserving learning opportunity.

Applications for Round 13 will open in March 2021.
